Global Graphics® is pleased to announce the release of Jaws PDF Editor™ 3.5. Several new features and improvements have been introduced into this release, including a new PostScript print engine.

New Features

- The performance of the rotate page functionality has been improved for PDF documents that have fewer than 150 pages.
- The performance of the page-merging functionality has been improved.
- A new version of the PostScript print engine has been incorporated.

Installation

Follow the procedure described below to install PDF Editor using the InstallShield wizard.

1. Make sure that you are logged on with administrator privileges.
2. Read the 'Upgrading' section below before installing this latest version of the application.
3. Navigate to the **Jaws PDF Editor** installation file: **JawsPDFEditor3.5.exe**
4. Double-click the installation program to start the InstallShield wizard
5. Follow the instructions in the wizard as they appear.
6. When prompted, enter your PDF Editor license key that has been given to you. Or, if you do not have a license key, enter "**EVALUATION**". This will allow you to run the application for 14-days before you are required to obtain a valid license key.

7. Click **Finish** to close the wizard and complete the installation procedure.

Upgrading

The following should be noted if you are upgrading from an existing version of PDF Editor:

- Upgrading from PDF Editor 1.x – You must uninstall this version before installing PDF Editor 3.0.
- Upgrading from PDF Editor 2.x or 3.0 – No need to uninstall this version before installing PDF Editor 3.5. Your settings and customizations will be migrated to the new version.

Silent Installation

1. Navigate to the Jaws PDF Editor 3.5 installation file.
2. In a command prompt box, enter the command:
`<setupfile.exe> -r`
3. Follow the instructions in the InstallShield wizard as normal to install PDF Editor and create a response file called setup.iss in your Windows folder.
4. If necessary you can open the response file in a text editor and edit it to suit your environment. For example, you may wish to change the user name parameter `szName` to use the system variable `%REGISTEREDOWNER%`.
like this:

```
szName=%REGISTEREDOWNER%
```

or

```
szName=%USERNAME%
```

Remember to use a multi-user license number in your response file and to set an installation folder which can be used on all user machines. After editing the response file, copy it to the Jaws PDF Editor 3.5 folder. You can now use the installer and the response file to silently install PDF Editor, as follows.

5. On the machine you want to silently install PDF Editor, log on as Administrator and enter this command to run the installation:

```
<PDF Editor folder>\<Setupfile.exe> -s -f1"Drive:\Folder\setup.iss"
```

(note that after the switch "-f1", the quotation marks containing the path and the .iss file, follow without a space!)

Uninstallation

To uninstall Jaws PDF Editor from your computer, do the following:

1. Click **Start > Settings > Control Panel** to open the **Windows Control Panel**.
2. Double-click **Add / Remove Programs** to open the **Add / Remove Programs** dialog.
3. Click the **Change** or **Remove Programs** button.
4. From the list of programs, choose **Jaws PDF Editor 3.5**.
5. Click **Remove**, and then close the **Add / Remove Programs** dialog when **PDF Editor** has been removed.
6. To complete the removal procedure, check that the folder below has been removed. If it is not, manually delete the folder:

C:\Program Files\Global Graphics\Jaws PDF Editor

Fixes and enhancements for PDF Editor 3.5

- 162855 PDF Editor now keeps a change to the rendering engine selection. After the application has been closed and reopened, the selection no longer reverts back to the default setting.
- 163026 Using the scrollbars, it is now possible to correctly navigate a document that is zoomed above 200% magnification
- 163056 The 'Delete All Comments' command – available by right-clicking the Comments tab – can now be selected.
- 163145 The selected item in a forms listbox that has a vertical scroll-bar no longer revert to the top-most item when the selection is confirmed
- 163154 Comment annotations that are positioned outside of the document display area are now forced to display within the document boundary
- 163172 Documents that contain large numbers of form fields are rendered to the screen much faster.
- 163379 The German / French user manuals are now correctly opened from the appropriate menu items / shortcuts.
- 163406 It is now no longer possible to print 'secured' pages in a document to an unsecured file, thereby bypassing PDF security
- 163407 The Fast Web View status of a document is now correctly displayed in the Document Properties display
- 163497 The mouse cursor is now correctly reset after clicking on an item in a forms listbox
- 163497 When using a list box in a PDF form, the behavior of the mouse cursor is now correct.
- 163500 When navigating a list box in a PDF form, it is now possible to use the keyboard arrow keys to move up and down the list.
- 163501 Tabbing between form fields is now possible in all zoom and view modes.
- 163518 Text searching in the 'up' direction now starts from where the mouse cursor is positioned in the document
- 163520 When installing PDF Editor in silent mode, the license key is no longer incorrectly installed to HKEY_CURRENT_USER in the registry, but is instead installed to HKEY_LOCAL_MACHINE.
- 163536 Having selected an item in a forms listbox, it is now possible to tab to

the next form field without having to click on the document first

- 163539 Tabbing between form fields when a PDF document is shown in a browser now works correctly
- 163541 When selecting items in a PDF form listbox, now you only have to click an item once in order to select it. Selecting with Shift+Click or Control+Click now also works correctly.
- 163614 Highlight comments now print correctly

Exclusions and known issues for PDF Editor 3.5

- 161304 Annotation comments in a printed document are printed in the location they appear in the PDF page, and may therefore obscure the text they are commenting on. Currently there is no facility in PDF Editor for choosing where you want comments to be printed.
- 161726 The recently used file list is not cleared from the File menu after removing and re-installing the application.
- 162156 Bounding boxes around hyperlinks are currently unsupported.
- 162241 The password entry dialog box incorrectly opens when attempting to display a password protected PDF in full screen mode.
- 162246 Deleting pages from a document by selecting the page thumbnail and pressing Delete is currently unsupported.
- 162255 The “Previous view” and “Next view” buttons do not currently support moving between PDF documents.
- 162346 There is an intermittent issue affecting the printing of multiple collated copies of a PDF document from PDF Editor that results in only one copy of the document being printed.
- 162593 The displayed error message text that appears when attempting to save a read-only file is not word-wrapped, but instead appears on one line in a long dialog box.
- 162659 PDF Editor does not currently support the ability to add external hyperlinks either between PDF files, URLs, or e-mail addresses. It also does not allow existing hyperlinks to be edited.
- 162769 Using a page thumbnail to insert a page into a PDF document may cause PDF Editor to quit unexpectedly.
- 162878 When printing an unsaved PDF document that has open annotation popup boxes or form fields, PDF Editor renames the document to a temporary file. Although the file has been renamed, it does not appear in the ‘most recently used’ list (under the File menu). If the document has not been saved prior to printing, changes to annotations will be lost in the original file.
- 162932 PDF Editor does not currently provide an option that allows form-fields to be visible when annotations are hidden.
- 163007 Roman characters do not appear in vertical text on Japanese and other non-Western systems when using a substitute font to replace missing fonts. This is because the standard MS-Mincho and MS-Gothic substitute fonts do not contain rotated Western glyphs.

- 163057 When several annotations have been selected in a PDF file the 'Export command' option does not appear in the right-click context menu.
- 163143 When using a combo-box in a PDF form, the first time an item is selected the item moves to the top of the list.
- 163268 PDF Editor does not warn you if you enter an invalid page range when extracting pages from a file.
- 163554 PDF form subsets, known as child-fields, are not currently supported by PDF Editor. This means, for example, that calculations will not work when entered into child-fields.
- 163834 Combo-boxes do not drop down when clicked using the down arrow button.
- 162018, 163211, 163728 The following form actions are not currently supported by PDF Editor: appending a page, save/save as file.
- 162992, 162926 PDF Editor does not currently support form-field data formatting and validation.
- 163017, 163005 PDF Editor does not currently support special number formatting in form-fields, such as negative values in parenthesis, or negative numbers in red.
- 163210, 162044 PDF Editor does not currently support text searching of PDF form data.
- 162932 Displaying annotations and form fields in thumbnail view is currently unsupported.
- 162054 When re-installing a PDF Editor trial version some days after a previous trial installation (but within the 14-day trial period), the trial version Dialog that comes up on the first start of PDF Editor spuriously shows a "14 days" trial period.
- 163985 Unpredictable behaviour can occur if PDF Editor is reinstalled into a path that is different from the previous install.
- 163538 Selection with confirmation in a list box does not activate the 'document has been modified' flag. Changes to the document in this state will not be saved.
- 163498 List boxes do not support confirmation of a newly selected value by pressing the Return key.
- 161321 Where file association for PDF files has been set to PDF Editor, uninstallation does not always reset file association 'away' from PDF Editor. In these instances, the PDF Editor icon will still be associated

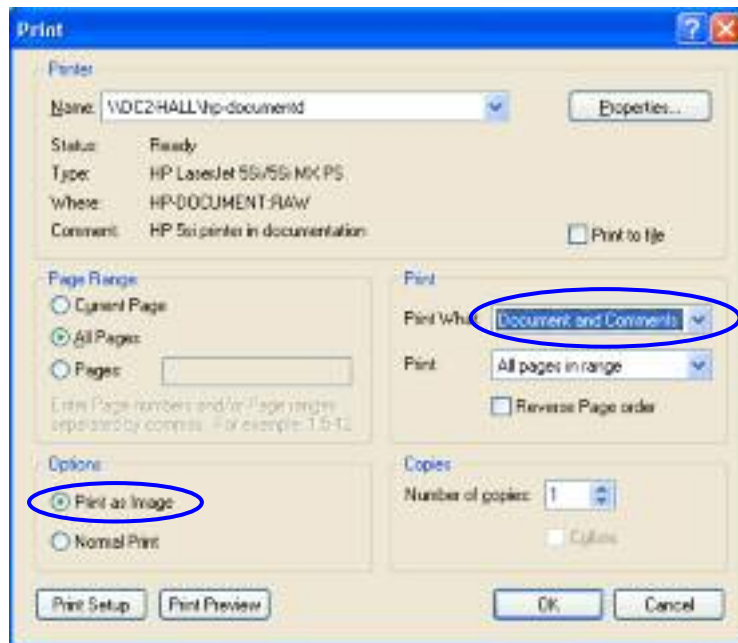
with PDF files.

- 163986 The original values remain when a selection in a multi-selection listbox is made with only one click. It is necessary to click twice to remove the other selections.

Special notices for this release

The following important points should be noted for this release of PDF Editor 3.5:

- PDF forms are not currently supported in web browsers.
- PDF Editor does not allow you to reply to annotations. Any file which contains ‘replied to annotations’ will open in PDF Editor, but the annotations will not be available to you.
- To print form-field data, such as the text in forms and check boxes, open the Print dialog (CTRL+P) shown below and select ‘Documents and comments’ from the Print What drop-down menu, and use the ‘Print as Image’ option.
